Welcome King Charles !

Britain's King Charles III and Queen Camilla will arrive in Paris on 20th September to start a three-day state visit in France. Accompanied by President Emmanuel Macron, they will lay a wreath at **the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier** under the Arc de Triomphe landmark in Paris. After a state dinner in Versailles, Macron and Charles will pay a visit to the Notre-Dame cathedral the following morning. The royal couple will then travel to Bordeaux, southwest France.

More than one in five children and teenagers in England (about 1.8 million) were "persistently absent" from school last year, new data shows. Before the Covid-19 pandemic, it was just over one in 10 students. Pupils count as persistently absent if they miss 10% or more of their school days. According to the Office of the Children's Commissioner, some are experiencing anxiety, others play truant.
